

Donation Information:

- The fund is part of the Allegany County Public Schools Foundation, a 501 C (3) charitable organization. Donations to the fund are tax deductible.
- The intent of the endowment fund is to reserve at least 50% of the total donations contributed each year so that the fund can continue to accrue on a yearly basis and become a true endowment.
- The committee will accept donations on behalf of the fund and will authorize all expenditures related to the fund.
- The committee, by majority vote, can approve the release of funds for qualified academic expenses and requests.
- All in-kind contributions must be approved by the committee and the principal of Mountain Ridge High School and follow all guidelines and policies as per the ACPS Board of Education.


Committee members consisting of parents and teachers from the Mountain Ridge community manage the endowment fund.


The following positions will be voted upon and filled every (2) years: (1) chairperson, (1) secretary, (1) reporting treasurer, and (2) community members.
